ORDER OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION

Pursuant to § 54.1-2408.1 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), a quorum of the Virginia Board of Medicine ("Board") met on September 10, 2014, by telephone conference call after a good faith effort to convene a regular meeting of the Board failed. The purpose of the meeting was to receive and act upon information indicating that John M. Stauffer, M.D., may have violated certain laws and regulations relating to the practice of medicine in the Commonwealth of Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

WHEREUPON, pursuant to its authority under § 54.1-2408.1 of the Code, the Board concludes that a substantial danger to the public health or safety warrants this action and ORDERS that the license of John M. Stauffer, M.D., to practice medicine in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED. It is further ORDERED that a hearing will be convened forthwith to receive and act upon evidence in this cause, and that the Executive Director of the Board shall be authorized to execute this Order and all other documents, notices, and Orders on behalf of the Board necessary to bring this matter to hearing.

Upon entry of this Order of Summary Suspension, the license of John M. Stauffer, M.D., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
