Dear Mr. Naik:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice as an occupational therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered September 27, 2007. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your athletic trainer license to William L. Harp, M.D., Executive Director for the Board of Medicine ("Board") at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Medicine for reinstatement of your athletic trainer license and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Medicine.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Medicine for reinstatement of your athletic trainer license, contact William L. Harp, M.D., Executive Director, at the above address or (804) 662-7009.

**ORDER**


In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, Sandra Whitley Ryals, Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Ramanuj Naik, O.T., was convicted of a felony charge in the Circuit Court of the County of Fairfax, for the Commonwealth of Virginia, to wit: Using a Computer to Solicit a Minor. A certified copy of the Sentencing Order is attached and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Ramanuj Naik, O. T., to practice as an Occupational Therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Ramanuj Naik, O.T., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current. Should Mr. Naik seek reinstatement of his license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, he shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of his license prior to issuance of his license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.



This case came before the Court for sentencing of the Defendant, who appeared in person with his Attorney, William Hassan and Karen Scarborough. The Commonwealth was represented by Faraji Rosenthal. The Defendant appeared while on bond.

On March 5, 2007, the Defendant was found guilty of the following offense:

The pre-sentence report was considered and is ordered filed as a part of the record in this case in accordance with the provisions of Code § 19.2-299.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the Defendant desired to make a statement and if the Defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court **SENTENCED** the Defendant to:

**INCARCERATION.** Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: **THREE YEARS.**

**SUSPENDED SENTENCE.** The Court further **ORDERED** that **TWO YEARS, ELEVEN MONTHS** of the sentence be suspended, for a period of twenty years, upon the following conditions:

**SUPERVISED PROBATION.** The Defendant is placed on probation to commence on his release from incarceration, under the supervision of a Probation Officer for three years, or unless sooner released by the Court or by the Probation Officer. The Defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer. Probation shall include a sexual offender evaluation, and the Defendant shall comply with all recommended treatment.

**COSTS.** The Defendant shall pay all costs of this case.

**CREDIT FOR TIME SERVED.** The Defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to §53.1-187 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended.

The Defendant was remanded to the custody of the Sheriff.


