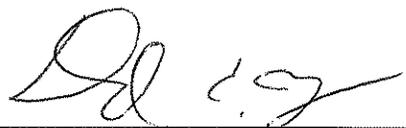
Decision:

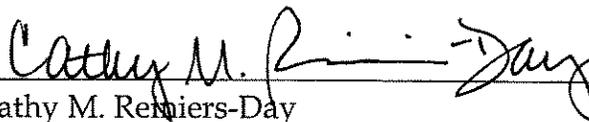
