

## **WHAT CAN A PRESCRIBER OR PHARMACIST DO WITH A PMP REPORT?**

1. A prescriber or pharmacist may discuss the information contained in the report with:
  - The patient for whom the report was generated
  - Another health care provider providing or initiating treatment for the patient
  - A dispenser who has dispensed medications for the patient
2. Release of the actual or copy of the report is prohibited by §54.1-2525 of the Code of Virginia.
3. A prescriber may make a note in the medical chart or a pharmacist may comment in the prescription record to document the use of program information in the treatment/dispensing decision process.

Note: A patient over the age of eighteen may request their report from the VPMP.
