OUTSTANDING PARTICIPATION

- ◆ Over **26,000 Physicians** submitted surveys.
- ◆ About three quarters of all licensed physicians in Virginia, including over 85% of renewing physicians.



OLDER PHYSICIANS WORKING LONGER

In 2010, more physicians age 55 and over kept full time hours than physicians of a similar age just two years earlier. Meanwhile, younger workers participated full-time at a lower rate. It remains to be seen if this is an artifact of the Great Recession, or indicates intergenerational differences in work habits.


CHANGING DEMOGRAPHICS



Older: The median age of Virginia's physicians was 49 in 2010, compared to 42 for Virginia's civilian labor force.

Increasingly Female: Virginia has more female physicians under age 35 than male. Males still account for two-thirds of Virginia's total physician workforce.

Diversity remains challenging: Asian-Americans make up a growing share of physicians, including 22% of those under age 40. Other racial and ethnic groups are underrepresented compared to Virginia's population.





Residency Location



- ◆ 22% graduated from Medical Schools in Virginia, including 11% who graduated from VCU's School of Medicine.
- ◆ 17.5% graduated from medical schools in a state bordering Virginia or the District of Columbia.
- ◆ 21% graduated from foreign medical schools.

- ◆ A third completed residencies in Virginia.
- ◆ 22% completed residencies in a state bordering Virginia or the District of Columbia.
- ◆ Only 13% completed both medical school and residencies in Virginia.

- ◆ *41% of Virginia's Physicians completed either medical school or a residency in Virginia.*
- ◆ *76% completed either medical school or a residency in Virginia or in a state bordering Virginia or the District of Columbia.*
