



This newsletter is designed to provide **prescribers** with information on how to utilize the MyRx Report found in the AWA^Rx^E application. MyRx is a useful tool and can be used to corroborate information contained in the Prescriber Report.

Where is the MyRx Report?

- MyRx is located in the AWA^Rx^E platform under the “RxSearch” tab.
- A DEA number must be listed in the AWA^Rx^E account in order to utilize the MyRx report feature.

What is it For?

- Prescribers can view dispensed prescription history attributed to their individual DEA number for the previous 10 months.
- The MyRx report can be used to confirm information on the quarterly prescriber report. For questions about the information reported for any drug class; select the time frame for the prescriber report, filter to view prescribing for a specific generic drug name, and obtain complete specifics for those prescriptions.
- Prescribers who find prescription information on the MyRx report that does not match information in a patient’s medical record should contact the pharmacy that dispensed the prescription to confirm the original prescription information. If your DEA number has been compromised, please contact law enforcement.

- Prescribers who have more than one DEA associated with their AWA^Rx^E account must run separate MyRx reports for each DEA number.
- The report may be exported as either a *pdf* file or a *csv* file.
- The MyRx report may identify prescriptions that may have been attributed to the incorrect prescriber’s DEA number. Though reporting errors are infrequent, dispenser selection of the incorrect prescriber may occur. Please contact the dispensing pharmacy to have this information corrected.

Note: The MyRx report or the prescriber report is viewable only by the specific prescriber.

An active AWA^Rx^E account must be maintained in order to view the MyRx report and to manage delegate users — even if the PMP is integrated into the facility’s EMR or EHR.
