### Prescription Monitoring Program Update

The Board of Veterinary Medicine (Board) in collaboration with the Prescription Monitoring (PMP) provides the following information:

As of July 1, 2018, veterinarians are required to report to the PMP under certain conditions. For more information on reporting requirements [Click Here](#).

The Board and PMP thank the veterinary community for being a part of the solution to address the opioid crisis. To further help in this effort, registration allowing an individual veterinarian access to the following two key reports is now available:

1. Animal Prescription History Report
  - Chronological list of prescriptions dispensed to an animal patient in the past two years
  - Animal prescriptions are recorded in the PMP under the *owner's name*
  - History of human prescriptions for owner is not available to veterinarians
2. "MyRx" Report
  - Displays a veterinarian's dispensed prescriptions for the previous 10 months
  - Reports may be saved as a pdf or excel file for future use

These free reports are available to veterinarians and only take a few minutes to register by following these steps:

1. Go to <https://virginia.pmpaware.net/login>
2. Click on "Create an Account" and enter the requested information
3. Choose "veterinarian" when selecting your role
