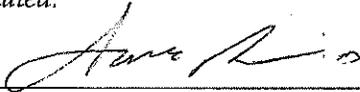

The Committee adjourned at 12:57 p.m.

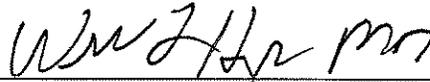

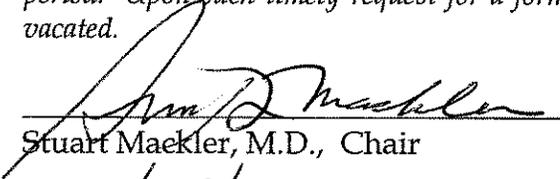

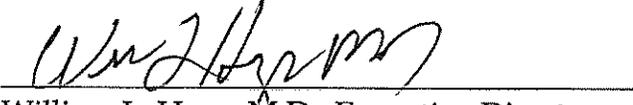
