
VOTE:

The Board received information from Ms. Robinson in order to determine whether Dr. Pole's ability to prescribe controlled substances constituted a substantial danger to public health and safety. Ms. Robinson provided details of the case to the members of the Board for their consideration.

DECISION:

On a motion by Dr. Reynolds, and duly seconded by Dr. Piness, the Board determined that Dr. Pole's ability to prescribe, dispense, and administer certain controlled substances constituted a substantial danger to the public health and safety and voted to summarily restrict his ability to prescribe, dispense, and administer Schedule 2 and 3 controlled substances simultaneous with the institution of proceedings for an informal conference pursuant to Va. Code §54.1-2408.1(B).


VOTE:

An informal conference will be scheduled before a Special Conference Committee of the Board for a final determination regarding this matter.


