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Naloxone Project - Fighting Opioid Overdoses with Antagonist Medications

Opioid overdoses are responsible for a significant number of deaths in the Commonwealth each year, be they in the context of legitimate treatment or abuse. Treatment with an opioid antagonist is essential to reversal of an overdose. Making naloxone or another antagonist more readily available in the community is seen as a way to combat the morbidity and mortality associated with opioid overdoses. In 2013 and 2015, the General Assembly passed law to address the treatment of an individual who is believed to be experiencing or is about to experience a life-threatening overdose. It modified the Drug Control Act by allowing a prescriber to provide naloxone or another antagonist to a person who believed he/she needed to have it on hand to combat an overdose in an individual whether it was occurring or might occur. The General Assembly made this possible by adding the words, “Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 54.1-3303, pursuant to an oral, written, or standing order issued by a prescriber”. As you may recall, Section 54.1-3303 requires a prescriber-patient relationship to lawfully issue a prescription. Subsection X of Section 54.1-3408 removes the requirement that the prescriber must have a bona fide relationship with the person who is requesting the antagonist or the intended recipient of the antagonist. The Board of Pharmacy was required to develop a protocol for dispensing naloxone or another antagonist with the assistance of the Board of Medicine and the Department of Health. The protocol outlines the requirements for standing orders. As a related matter, prescribers may wish to consider prescribing naloxone to their patients who are on large amounts of opioids, in case of an accidental overdose.

Required Registration with the Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP)

In 2014, the General Assembly underscored the importance of the PMP in the identification, prevention and intervention of controlled substance misuse, abuse, dependence and diversion when it passed a law that required prescribers with a current active license with the Board of Medicine to become registered with the PMP by January 1, 2016. If you are not already registered to use the PMP, you are encouraged to register now, or you will be registered using information from the Department of Health Profession's licensing system by January 1, 2016. *Please note that a valid personal e-mail address is required for the creation and use of a PMP account.* To confirm that DHP has a current valid email address for you, please do the following *now*:

1. Go to <http://www.dhp.virginia.gov/>
2. Under the heading: "Services for Practitioners" on the left side: Select "Update Your Information"
3. Select "Continue to the Login Page"
4. Once logged in, Click on "Mailing Address Change", then "Address of Record". Update or add your *email address* as necessary.

After your e-mail address is submitted to DHP, the registration process for the PMP will proceed automatically. You will be sent an e-mail that assigns you a username and temporary password. Once you receive this e-mail, the following steps are necessary to activate your PMP account:

1. Go to the DHP website and select "Prescription Monitoring Program" on the left side.
2. Go to "Access the PMP DataCenter" and enter your username and temporary password.
3. You will be directed to a screen to finish activating your account, which includes adding your DEA registration number or other information and selecting answers to security questions needed for password reset features.

Once these steps are complete, the PMP account is active and ready to be used. The account can only be activated by accessing the system with the provided username and temporary password.

Further, the law requires a check of the PMP when you are starting a patient on an opioid or benzodiazepine that you anticipate will be given for more than 90 days. Also, if you do office-based opioid addiction treatment with buprenorphine, you are required to check the PMP at the beginning of treatment.

New Laws from the 2015 General Assembly

These bills all became law on or before July 1, 2015.

SB1235 & HB1445 - Companion bills that authorize an MD or DO to issue a certification for the use of cannabidiol oil or THC-A oil for the treatment of intractable epilepsy. HB1435 - Adds licensed physician assistants and nurse practitioners to the list of individuals that may be appointed to serve as medical examiners. <http://leg1.state.va.us/cgi-bin/legp504.exe?151+ful+HB1435ER>

HB1458 - Authorizes a practitioner to prescribe naloxone or other opioid antagonist to a person for administration to a second person when that second person is experiencing or is about to experience a life-threatening opiate overdose, provided that the naloxone product is approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for such purpose. <http://leg1.state.va.us/cgi-bin/legp504.exe?151+ful+HB1458ER>

HB1476 - Allows a nurse practitioner to testify as an expert witness in a court of law on certain matters within the scope of his activities and adds nurse practitioner to the definition of "health care provider" under the medical malpractice statutes. <http://leg1.state.va.us/cgi-bin/legp504.exe?151+ful+HB1476ER>

HB1657 - Adds a section to the suggested form of written advance directives that allows a declarant to add specific instructions for life-prolonging procedures in case the declarant is pregnant when her attending physician determines that she has a terminal condition. <http://leg1.state.va.us/cgi-bin/legp504.exe?151+ful+HB1657ER>

HB1750 - Allows expanded access to investigational drugs, biological products and devices. <http://leg1.state.va.us/cgi-bin/legp504.exe?151+ful+HB1750ER>

HB1775 - Provides that medical experts licensed in other states, but not in Virginia, are presumed to know the standard of care in Virginia, provided they meet the educational and examination requirements for licensure in Virginia. The bill extends this presumption to all health care providers who are licensed to practice in Virginia, a presumption which is currently limited to physicians and nurses. <http://leg1.state.va.us/cgi-bin/legp504.exe?151+ful+HB1775ER>

HB1818 - Changes the term "respiratory care practitioner" to "respiratory therapist". Also changes the term "x-ray" to "ionizing radiation" in the context of radiologic technology and updates the definition of "radiologic technologist". <http://leg1.state.va.us/cgi-bin/legp504.exe?151+ful+HB1818ER>

HB1839 - Classifies tramadol as Schedule IV and removes hydrocodone combination products from Schedule III, now that hydrocodone is Schedule II. <http://leg1.state.va.us/cgi-bin/legp504.exe?151+ful+HB1839ER>
