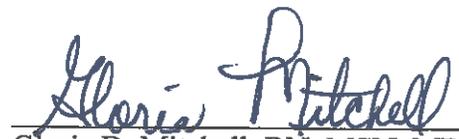
RECONVENTION: The Committee reconvened in open session at 5:54 P.M.
