- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Dr. Montero, and duly seconded by Ms. Maddux, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Schultz. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Dixon attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of the Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.

The Committee adjourned at 4:25 p.m.


