Dr. Paino did not appear. Ms. Palmatier informed the Committee that the Notice was sent by regular and certified mail to Dr. Paino's address of record with the Board, and that the certified mail receipt card was returned from the post office with a date of delivery of May 29, 2013, and the name of David Paino was printed where it indicated "received by" and then a signature. The Committee Chair ruled that proper notice had been provided to Dr. Paino and the informal conference proceeded in his absence.

The Committee reviewed Dr. Paino's Application for a Permit to Administer Conscious/Moderate Sedation by an enteral method in the Commonwealth of Virginia, and the allegations set forth in a Notice of the Board dated May 10, 2013.

Closed Meeting:

Ms. Swain moved that the Committee convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of David Paino. Additionally, Ms. Swain moved that Ms. Palmatier, Ms. Lee and Ms. Roukous attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting is deemed necessary and their presence will aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and passed.

Reconvene:

Ms. Swain moved that the Committee certify that it heard, discussed or considered only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened. The motion was seconded and passed.

Ms. Roukous reported that the Committee found Dr. Paino did not meet the requirements of 18VAC60-20-120.C of the Board of Dentistry's 2005 Regulations Governing the Practice of Dentistry and further defined in Section III of the American Dental Association's 2005 Guidelines for Teaching the Comprehensive Control of Anxiety and Pain in Dentistry, which were in effect at the time Dr. Paino's training occurred, in that he had not completed a required continuing education course that consists of not less than 18 hours of didactic instruction, plus at least 20 clinically-oriented experiences, including hands-on clinical participation.

The Committee agreed to recommend to the Board that Dr. Paino's Application for a Permit to Administer Conscious/Moderate Sedation by an enteral method in the Commonwealth of Virginia be denied.


Dr. Gaskins moved to adopt the decision of the Committee. The motion was seconded and passed.

Upon a motion by Dr. Gaskins, the minutes from the Credentials Committee meeting conducted on May 17, 2013 were approved.


ADJOURNMENT:
