- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:22 a.m.

DECISION:

Upon a motion by General Adams-Ender, and duly seconded by Dr. Bassam, the Committee voted to refer this matter to the Board for a formal hearing since suspension or revocation of Dr. McLean's license may be justified which is not within the authority of this Committee pursuant to Va. Code Section 54.1-2400 (10).

ADJOURNMENT:

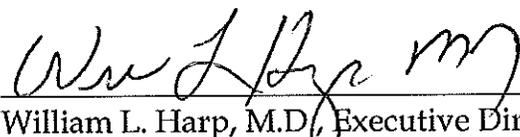

The Committee adjourned at 1:35 p.m.

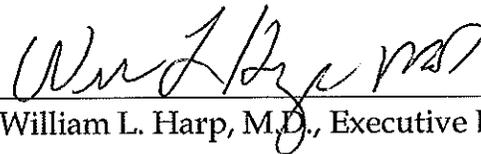
