- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:07 a.m.

Additionally, she moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Dixson attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
- RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.

Upon a motion by Mr. Heretick, and duly seconded by Dr. Bell, the Committee made certain Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and voted to impose a monetary penalty and issue Dr. Coleman a reprimand and subject his license to certain terms and conditions.

The Committee adjourned at 1:27 p.m.

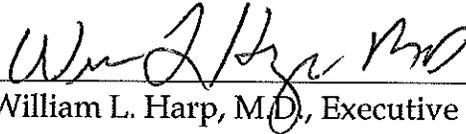
