Dr. Montero moved that Dr. Levin be exonerated. Hearing no second, the motion failed.


Upon a motion by Dr. Hoffman, and duly seconded by Dr. Jadhav, the Committee voted that the matter be dismissed.

The vote was 2-1 with Dr. Montero voting "no".


