ADJOURNMENT:

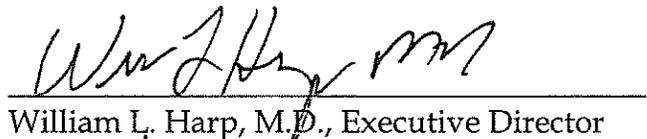

The Committee adjourned at 4:29 p.m.

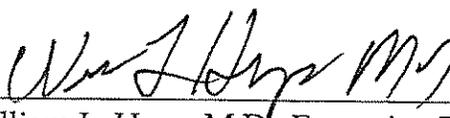

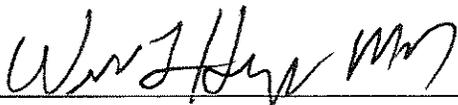
