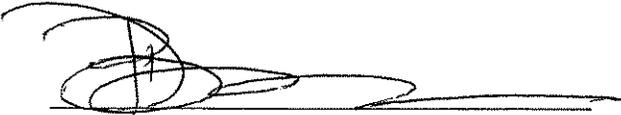
- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:18 a.m.

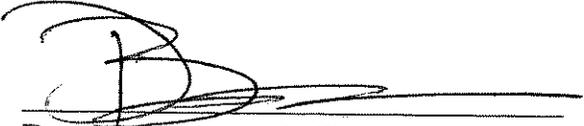
VOTE:

The Committee adjourned at 12:35 p.m.

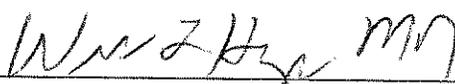
