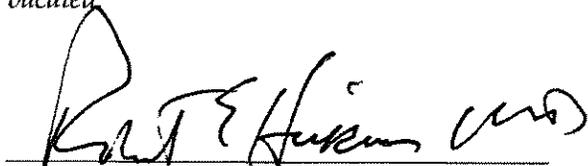

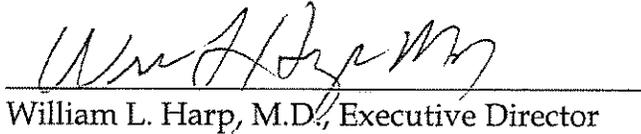

Upon a motion by Dr. Clements, and duly seconded by Dr. Davé, the Committee voted to exonerate Dr. Molle.

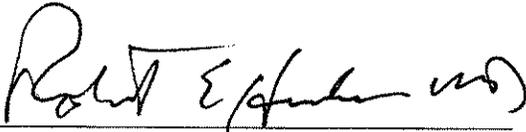

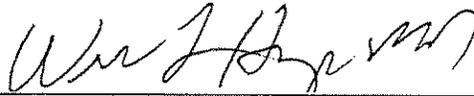

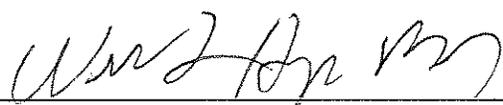
