The Chair ruled that Mr. Osadiaye was properly noticed, therefore, the informal conference would proceed in his absence.


The Committee considered the evidence before it and information provided by Ms. Yelverton regarding the allegations in the Notice.



the authority of the Committee pursuant to §54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia.




