**DECISION:**

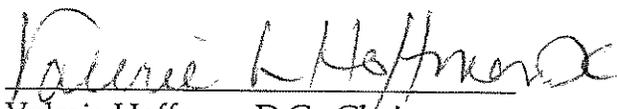

**ADJOURNMENT:**

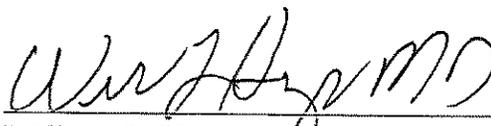
