DISCUSSION:

Dr. Stanga appeared before the Board in person in accordance with the Board's Notice of Formal Hearing dated January 15, 2013. Dr. Stanga acknowledged that he was not represented by counsel but wished to proceed with the formal hearing regarding his petition for reinstatement.

The Board received sworn testimony from witnesses called by the Commonwealth and from Dr. Stanga regarding the allegations in the Notice and his petition for reinstatement.

CLOSED SESSION:

Upon a motion by Dr. Reynolds, and duly seconded by Dr. Mackler, the Board voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Stanga. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Barrett, Ms. Deschenes, and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Board in its deliberations.

RECONVENE:

Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Board re-convened in open session and announced its decision.

DECISION:

Upon a motion by Dr. Piness, and duly seconded by Dr. Mackler, the Board made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to continue Dr. Stanga's license on indefinite suspension subject to certain terms and conditions.

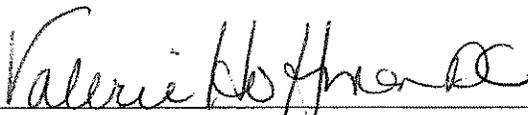
VOTE:

ADJOURNMENT:

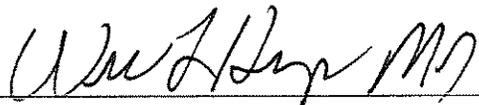
The Board adjourned at 12:55 p.m.
