CALL TO ORDER: A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:45 a.m.

MATTER: William V. Tynes, II, M.D. License No.: 0101-016018
Case Nos.: 131469, 135866, 136517

PRELIMINARY MATTER: The Chair noted that the time was 9:46 a.m., and Dr. Tynes had been noticed to appear before the Committee at 9:30 a.m. and was not present.

Mr. Milsky advised that Notice of Informal Conference and a subsequent time change letter had been sent to Dr. Tynes address of record with the Board by overnight and 1st class mail. Tracking for the overnight mailing indicated that the mailing had been delivered. Mr. Milsky further advised that none of the mailings had been returned. Further, Dr. Tynes had left a voice mail message for him which indicated that he had received the Board's Notice.

RULING: Based upon the representations of Adjudication Specialist Gerald Milsky, the Chair ruled that proper notice had been made to Dr. Tynes' regarding the informal conference, therefore, the informal conference would proceed in his absence.

DISCUSSION:

Dr. Tynes did not appear before the Committee in person in accordance with a Notice of the Board dated March 4, 2013, nor was he represented by counsel at the informal conference.

The Committee received information regarding the allegations from Mr. Milsky and considered the evidence before it.

DECISION:

Upon a motion by Dr. Hickman, and duly seconded by Dr. Hoffman, the Committee made certain Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and voted to impose Dr. Tynes a monetary penalty, issue him a reprimand and subject his license to certain terms.

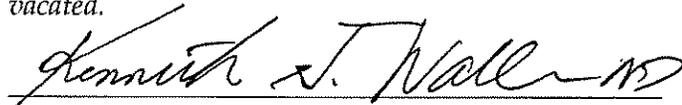
VOTE:

Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of the Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.

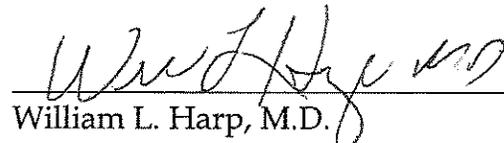
