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- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:23 a.m.

- DISCUSSION:** Dr. Erskine appeared before the Committee in person in accordance with a Notice of the Board dated July 23, 2013, after waiving 30-days notice prior to the convening of this informal conference. Dr. Erskine was represented by Michael L. Goodman, Esquire and Eileen Talmante, Esquire.
- The Committee reviewed Dr. Erskine's petition for reinstatement and fully discussed the allegations in the Notice with Dr. Erskine.
- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Dr. Allison-Bryan, and duly seconded by Mr. Signer, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Erskine. Additionally, she moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Wood attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

**RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.



If service of the Order is made by mail three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of the Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.*
