- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:05 a.m.

The Committee adjourned at 3:10 p.m.

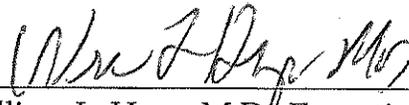
