DECISION:


Upon a motion by Dr. Allison-Bryan, and duly seconded by Dr. Taminger, the Committee voted to dismiss the matter.

Ms. Bennett advised that the Notice had been sent to Dr. Villarroel's address of record with the Board by overnight and 1st class mail.

RULING: Based on the information provided by Ms. Bennett, the Chair determined that proper notice had been provided to Dr. Villarroel, therefore, the informal conference would proceed in his absence.

ADJOURNMENT:


The Committee adjourned at 2:22 p.m.
