On a motion by Dr. Mackler, and duly seconded by Dr. Lee, the Board determined that Dr. Loftus' ability to practice constituted a substantial danger to the public health and safety and voted to summarily suspend his license simultaneous with the institution of proceedings for a formal administrative hearing pursuant to Section 54.1-2408.1 of the Code of Virginia.


VOTE:
