On a motion by Dr. Mackler, and duly seconded by Dr. Frantz, the Board determined that Dr. Gomez's ability to practice constituted a substantial danger to the public health and safety and voted to summarily restrict his license from prescribing Schedule II and III controlled drugs simultaneous with the institution of proceedings for an informal conference hearing pursuant to Section 54.1-2408.1 of the Code of Virginia.
