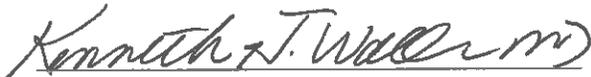
VOTE:

ADJOURNMENT:

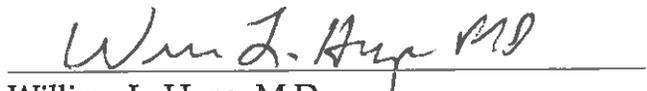
The Committee adjourned at 11:09 a.m.
