[Continuing Education Requirements – 2021 Renewals](#)

Due to ongoing concerns with the COVID emergency and access to continuing education courses, licensees have been granted a partial exemption from completing 10 hours of continuing education for purpose of 2021 licensure renewals. This means that, for renewal of licenses by March 31, 2021, licensees will be required to attest to completion of 10 CE contact hours for the previous year (from April 1, 2020-March 31, 2021) instead of the usual 20 CE contact hours in order to renew their licenses.
