CALL TO ORDER: A meeting of a Special Conference Committee of the Board of Pharmacy was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

Ryan H. LeBlanc appeared with Crystal LeBlanc, his spouse; Judy Champlin, his mother; and Helene Anderson-Grant and Donna Whitney, HPIP Case Managers, to discuss his application for licensure as a pharmacist and allegations that he may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy as stated in the October 28, 2008 Notice.

Closed Meeting: Upon a motion by Mr. Yi and duly seconded by Mr. Kozera, the Committee unanimously voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711.A.(28) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Ryan H. LeBlanc. Additionally, he moved that Cathy Reiniers-Day and Mykl Egan attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

Reconvene: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open meeting.

Decision: Upon a motion by Mr. Yi, and duly seconded by Mr. Kozera, the Committee made certain Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law and unanimously voted to grant his application for licensure with certain terms and conditions.

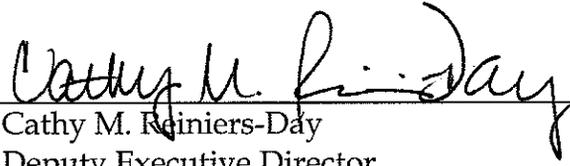
Decision:

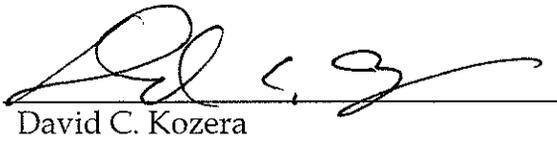

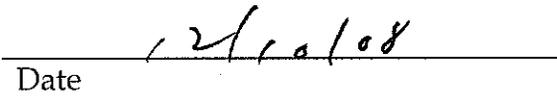
