CALL TO ORDER: A meeting of a Special Conference Committee of the Board of Pharmacy was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

Brenda A. Schoonover appeared with Whitney Watts and Morgan Schoonover, her daughters; and Larry Price and Bill Gallahan, pharmacists; who spoke on her behalf to discuss her petition for reinstatement of her pharmacist license and to review allegations that she may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy as stated in the February 7, 2012, Notice.

Closed Meeting: Upon a motion by Ms. Stelly, and duly seconded by Mr. Yi, the Committee unanimously voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711.A(28) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Brenda R. Schoonover. Additionally, she moved that Cathy Reiniers-Day and Mykl Egan attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

Reconvene: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open meeting and announced the decision.

Decision:

Upon a motion by Ms. Stelly, and duly seconded by Mr. Yi, the Committee made certain Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law and unanimously voted to reinstate Ms. Schoonover's license to practice as a pharmacist.

As provided by law, this decision shall become a final Order thirty (30) days after service of such Order on Ms. Schoonover, unless a written request is made to the Board requesting a formal hearing on the allegations made against her is received from Ms. Schoonover within such time. If service of the Order is made by mail, three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of this Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.

Rachel J. Mitchell did not appear, however, the committee chose to proceed in her absence as the notice was mailed to Ms. Mitchell's legal address of record. The committee discussed that she may have violated portions of the laws and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy technicians as stated in the February 8, 2012, Notice.

Mitchell. Additionally, she moved that Cathy Reiniers-Day and Mykl Egan attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

Reconvene:

Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open meeting and announced the decision.

Decision:

Upon a motion by Ms. Stelly, and duly seconded by Mr. Yi, the Committee adopts the Findings of

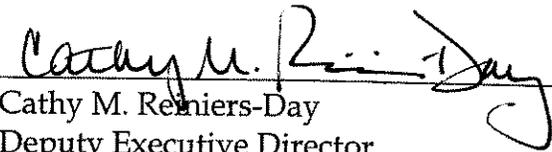
