

Enforcement Workgroup Accepted Recommendations

- Referral from Storage and Disposal Workgroup to work with Education Workgroup to develop communication plan to increase law enforcement awareness of disposal opportunities
- Will address recommendation at next workgroup meeting





Enforcement Workgroup Accepted Recommendations

- Referral from Education Workgroup to develop law enforcement training on administration of Naloxone if pilot is expanded to include law enforcement
- Will address recommendation at next workgroup meeting

- 1) Legislative Recommendations
- 2) Enforcement Workgroup Referrals
 - 1) Treatment Workgroup – identify alternatives to incarceration
 - 2) Treatment Workgroup – identify entry points for treatment into criminal justice system
 - 3) Education Workgroup – establish multi-disciplinary education




