- 43,000 youth currently receive substance-use prevention education
- Tobacco Only: 4 grantees
- General Substance-Use Prevention: 18 grantees
- Alcohol, Tobacco & Marijuana: 32 grantees

- Tobacco, Alcohol, Marijuana & Other Substances: 12 grantees
